



**Nomination of community representatives to the Consultative Council for Communities:  
Montenegrin community-specific workshops, Graçanicë/Gracanica**

*11 December 2009*

On 11 December, the Secretariat of the Consultative Council for Communities (CCC) and the European Centre for Minority Issues Kosovo (ECMI Kosovo) organised a meeting in Prishtinë/Priština with representatives of the Montenegrin community, with the aim of providing technical support for the nomination of community membership to the CCC.

Present at the meeting were 5 representatives from Montenegrin civil society, including CCC member Mr Slobodan Vujičić; and ECMI Kosovo representatives, Mr Gazmen Salijević and Ms Katherine Nobbs.

Ms Nobbs gave a brief presentation on the technical requirements for accreditation of a Community Representative Organisation (CRO), and submission of a nominee.

Community representatives explained that they were unhappy with the selection of the NGO Komitet Žena as the organisation to be put forward for accreditation, arguing that its work focused on gender issues and not on the Montenegrin community. Instead, they suggested that the organisation **Udrezenje Crnogoraca Kosova** be accredited. This was accepted by all representatives present. Ms Nobbs noted that representatives from Komitet Žena, who were not present at the meeting, would need to be informed, and that ECMI Kosovo would undertake the responsibility of contacting them.

Participants then unanimously selected current CCC member **Mr Slobodan Vujičić** as their nominee.
